Due to the ongoing Covid -19 pandemic restriction on gathering in person our Annual Meeting will be held virtually, via Zoom on **January 31, 2021 at 10:30 am**. We will take a short break after the 9 am Worship Service and return at 10:30 am to begin the Annual Meeting reflecting on our past and considering our future. The meeting will be accessed using the link or dial in number for the Sunday morning Worship Service found on the St. David's Church Events page. In addition, all communications and documents related to the Annual Meeting will be available for download from the Events page. If you do not have internet connection, documents will be mailed to you.

At the Annual Meeting we will elect a Jr. Warden, three Vestry members and three Delegates and two Alternate Delegates to represent St. David's Church at the Diocesan Convention and Convocation. Parishioners who are 16 years of age or older, attending worship regularly, and are givers of record for six months prior to the elections are eligible to vote.

Guidance for attending and participating at the Annual Meeting:

- Access the meeting via – Sunday – 9 am ZOOM service, on the St. David's Church Events page. Opening of the meeting will begin at 10:15am. If you plan on attending the meeting via telephone, please inform the office **by January 21st** so that arrangements can be made for you to receive the Annual Reports and have your vote registered.
- Voting will be conducted using ZOOM polling feature. Each device will represent only one voting member. If you wish to have multiple votes per household, it will be necessary to log on using multiple devices.
- If you wish to make a point of order or be recognized by the chair, use the blue "raised hand" option found in the lower right of the participant window. Those accessing the meeting by phone may seek to be recognized by dialing *9.
- Please wait to be recognized by the chair before you speak.
