The Advent season is upon us, and will probably feel very condensed this year. Since the Fourth Sunday of Advent falls on Christmas Eve, it is one of the shortest that we will have on any given calendar year. However, it does not mean that we should be any less attentive to the meaning of this season. Our change of color (blue) and our change in worship (Advent hymns) add to the feeling. In this period of anticipation we will decorate both our homes and our church with Advent wreaths, lighting a candle for each week and focusing our prayers on the themes of the season.

To support this way of viewing Advent, our program this year will highlight the topics symbolized by each of the candles and give opportunities to contemplate what each means to us in our spiritual life. Beginning on December 3rd, there will be a daily meditation for each week, using quotes and hymns and bible verses to create a thoughtful space. The four areas of contemplation are:

Hope – the word has many layers to it. There is a sense of anticipation for something in the future, a potential outcome that we desire. Our hope in God is often what can get us through rough times, and help us to celebrate the good times. Hope is the greatest gift we have been given and the gift that we can share with others. During Advent, we hope for the coming of the Christ and acceptance into the Kingdom of God.

Peace – in a time where chaos, turmoil and upheaval can feel common in every day, the search for peace may seem futile. Yet the moments when we find a calmness or a quietness, a harmony in an unexpected way, or a steadiness in activity around us feel like precious gifts. Peace can be large or small, long term or fleeting, but it is always held in our hearts as special.

Joy – is so much more than happiness, cheerfulness or fun. Joy feels like it comes from the depth of our souls and overwhelms us, and cannot be conquered by any negativity. Like a candle burning brightly to defeat the darkness, joy is irreplaceable. Traditions new and old help to kindle that sense of joy and wonder in all we do.

Love – pure and eternal, love is the power of God to make everything right in the world. Love for each other is essential to our lives as disciples. To be able to love unconditionally, and to know that God loves us all unconditionally, is at the very heart of who we are as human beings. Love can be found everywhere, as long as we continue to look and to offer it from our hearts.

December Outreach of the Month Liberty Maternity Clinic

In keeping with our 2023 outreach theme of social justice, the monthly outreach target for December is Liberty Maternity Clinic in Kampala, Uganda. This clinic is charitable-funded by US-based charity, Metropolitan Communities. One of the principals of this charity is our congregation member, Rev. Dr. David Williams, who serves at this clinic during some of his medical mission trips to Africa. It operates as a free ob gyn and maternity clinic for poorer residents with means-tested charges for others. This clinic is located in an impoverished section of Kampala. The payroll includes doctors, nurses, administrator, and security staff. Without this clinic, many local expectant mothers would be too far away from affordable medical care.




