Alleluia, Christ is risen - the Lord is risen indeed!

The 50 Days of the Easter Season are the most joyful and exciting of all the calendar year. The symbolism of Holy Week is ancient and deep, and our returning sense of hope and wonder is even stronger because of it. We have brought the new fire into the church at the Easter Vigil, and found the tomb is empty. All of us have been renewed and recommitted. It is a joyous time to be alive.

The Easter season lasts until the day of Pentecost – May 28th – when we celebrate the arrival of the Holy Spirit, the first gift given to those who believe. During this season we can find many ways to give thanks for the resurrection of Jesus Christ, and one recent tradition here at St. David's is to have a campaign that helps us as individuals support our congregation from the abundance of joy we feel in the spring.

One of our faithful families has offered to match donations of up to \$10,000 to help support the many ministries here. So all we need to do is offer a donation of any amount to this cause, and when we all together raise \$10,000 our total effort will be \$20,000. This year's theme is Growing in Faith, reflecting how we as a community continue to flourish and thrive. Keep an eye out for ways to see this theme reflected around the church over the rest of the Easter season!

For years (even decades) there has been much anxiety around the idea that churches are shrinking, and that Christianity as a whole is dying. For those outside the church this may seem like a reality, but for those of us who believe in the resurrection, it has only been an adjustment. Places like St. David's continue to thrive because we are a people of faith, and because we are so engaged in our larger community. Growing in Faith is a profound way to see our future, both as individuals and as a parish. As we deepen our spiritual connections we deepen our roots in this neighborhood. Our own growth adds to the growth of our parish in very real ways.

Get Ready for Some Summer 2023 Outreach Projects!!! Urban Promise - (July 10 – 14)

St. David's will provide 1 week of snacks and drinks for one of two summer camp sites for the 2023 Urban Promise ministry program in Trenton. Again, this year, Summer Camp gives kids grades 1-8 the opportunity to have FUN throughout the day with the help of dedicated interns, staff, and community groups. The vision to create an Urban Promise ministry program in Trenton became a reality in 2011 when UPTrenton held its first Summer Camp on West State Street. Enthusiasm about the camp was so great that we opened our doors for a free After School program that same year. In the fall of 2014, we opened our second site in east Trenton in collaboration with the East Trenton Collaborative. We have continued to operate After School and Summer Camp, and Street Leader programs in two locations. In addition, we offer a Youth College Readiness Program, an outdoor experiential learning program, Trenton Trekkers, and a College Scholarship Program. More information will follow with requests for specific bagged snacks and drinks. Please consider donating to this wonderful program for our kids living in Trenton!
