As discussed during Sunday's church service, the decision was made to move our Services to the Zoom platform. The first service on Zoom will be this **Sunday, May 10th.** 

A test run will take place this Friday night after evening prayer @ 7:30 pm. It's recommended you try and log into Zoom at this time to see if you have any issues.

Here are the basics for zoom!

To log in to the meeting, you will click the link at <u>stdavidscranbury.com/events</u> as usually. You may be prompted to install Zoom, if so, please click or tap yes.

As is true with GoToMeeting, you do not need a Zoom account to join a Zoom meeting.

For security reasons and to prevent Zoom bombing, you will not be able to join the meeting until a host or co-host allows you in the room. Please be patient as we let everyone in.

For those using a computer or using the app on a cell phone or tablet, controls to mute, turn video on and off are at the bottom of the screen. On a computer the chat toggle is there as well. On mobile, this can be reached by tapping "more" at the bottom of the screen. On a computer, the layout of the participants can be changed in the up right corner.

\*6 toggles the mute/unmute.
